Temporary Westbound and Eastbound Lane Closure in the Unit block, 200 to 500 Blocks of Malcolm X Avenue, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins September 24, 2024, to September 27, 2024

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming milling and paving restoration in Unit block, 200 to 500, blocks of Malcolm X, Avenue, SE, between Oakwood Street, SE, and the 295 Ramp SE, (weather permitting)

The lane closures are estimated to last **4 days** for milling and paving restoration. (weather permitting). This work is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
