Temporary Westbound and Eastbound Lane Closure in the Unit block, 200 to 500 Blocks of Malcolm X Avenue, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 Begins October 12, 2024, to November 30, 2024

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming milling and paving and line stripping restoration in the **Unit block, 200 to 500, blocks of Malcolm X, Avenue, SE, between Martin Luther King, Jr Avenue, SE, and the 295 Ramp SE**, (weather permitting)

The lane closures are estimated to last **6 weeks** for milling and paving restoration. (weather permitting). This work is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative’s Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
