RE: Important Notice of Road Closure and Detour on the 400 and 500 Blocks of Lebaum Street, SE

Dear Resident(s),

We're informing you that the District of Columbia Powerlines Underground (DC PLUG) Initiative's Feeder 15166 is nearing the completion of its civil construction phase. Consequently, our dedicated contractors will soon begin milling and paving in the 400 and 500 blocks of Lebaum Street, SE.

The restoration work will begin on October 21, 2024, and continue until October 31, 2024, weather permitting. Construction hours are Monday through Saturday, from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. **Detours are as follows:**

If you're driving westbound on Lebaum Street SE:

- Turn left onto Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue SE.
- Make a right onto Mellon Street SE.
- Then, turn right onto 5th Street, followed by another right onto 4th Street.
- This will bring you back to Lebaum Street SE.

During the milling and paving restoration period, all traffic will be detoured to accommodate the large equipment for this operation. We kindly request your cooperation in refraining from street parking in the affected areas. We sincerely understand the inconvenience, however, the longer it takes residents to relocate their vehicles the longer the process will take. We are asking residents to please adhere to the No Parking signs posted in these locations. Weather permitting, this phase of restoration is expected to last approximately ten (10) days. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work towards enhancing the reliability and resilience of the District of Columbia.
