(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming southbound lane closures to install manholes, conduits, and PCC base restoration in the 2900 to 3000 blocks of Martin Luther King Jr, Avenue, SE between Malcolm X, Avenue, SE, and Labaum Street, SE, (weather permitting). Installation of manholes, conduits, and roadway base restoration is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
