Temporary Southbound and Northbound Lane Closures from the 200 and 400 Blocks of Orange Street, SE, For DC PLUG Feeder 15166 begin on August 27, 2024, to September 6, 2024.

(WASHINGTON, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) advises stakeholders to expect delays due to upcoming lane closures for asphalt base, sidewalk, curb and gutter and driveway restoration on the **200 and 400 blocks of Orange Street, SE between 2nd Street, NE, and 5th Street, SE (weather permitting). The installation of asphalt base, sidewalk curb and gutter and driveway restoration are necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.**

The lane closures are estimated to last 4 weeks for asphalt base, sidewalk, curb and gutter and driveway restoration (weather permitting). The installation of asphalt base, sidewalk, curb and gutter and driveway restoration is necessary to complete the DC PLUG initiative's Feeder 15166 project which consists of undergrounding powerlines for a more resilient DC.
