This letter serves as an official project closeout communication from the DC PLUG Feeder 14758 underground civil construction project team.

The District of Columbia Power Line Undergrounding Initiative (DC PLUG) has been a joint effort between the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) and Pepco to minimize the impact of severe storms on the city's electric system. The 385-day project in the Blue Plains and Bellevue neighborhoods concludes on October 28, 2024.

During this project, the DC PLUG civil construction team installed key infrastructure components, including manholes, transformer enclosures, and tapholes, to enhance the overall reliability and service quality for residents, businesses, and stakeholders. We are pleased to announce that the civil construction phase has been completed successfully, in accordance with the contractual specifications. The electrical construction is up next.
