



For contractors who want to stay apprised of the status of the DC PLUG initiative, what is the best source of information?

- The DC PLUG website (www.dcpluginfo.com) is the best place for contractors to find information on the DC PLUG initiative.

When can we expect an update on the schedule for the projects to be completed in the First Biennial Plan?

- The DC PLUG team filed an updated project schedule with the Public Service Commission on February 7, 2018, for work to be performed in the First Biennial Plan. That schedule is available on the Public Service Commission website [here](#).

What type of work will be contracted for DC PLUG?

- There are multiple types of work that will be contracted, including: civil engineering design, civil construction (installation of conduit and manholes), electrical engineering design, high voltage electrical construction (pulling cable, setting transformers), construction management (Quality Assurance/Quality Control) and overhead electric equipment removal. The Request For Proposals for construction work related to Feeder 308 was released on February 15, 2018, and is available on the District of Columbia Office of Contracting and Procurement website [here](#).

Does Pepco plan to hire a Program Manager for DC PLUG?

- Yes, Pepco will hire a program manager to cover project controls and coordinate with DDOT's program manager.

Does Pepco plan to hire a Construction Management firm for DC PLUG?

- Yes, Pepco will hire some construction management firms to manage construction of the electric distribution portion of the underground feeders and to provide QA/QC for civil construction.

The Request for Proposals for the civil construction of Feeder 308 will be released as an open contract. Will comparable work on future feeders be solicited as CBE set-asides or open to the market?

- At this time, it has not been determined whether solicitations for similar work on future feeders will be set-asides for CBEs.

Can a contractor win more than one bid for DC PLUG projects at the same time?

- Yes.

Could you speak to what, if any, opportunities there will be for non-CBE prime contractors in the DC PLUG initiative?

- The legislation creating the DC PLUG initiative includes ambitious goals for using District businesses for DC PLUG work, where qualified. CBE participation will be considered when evaluating bids for DC PLUG work. We strongly encourage non-CBE firms to form relationships with CBE firms to demonstrate a strong commitment to CBE participation in future DC PLUG bids.
